Open Access (rights and permissions)

At JEB, we realise that different authors may have different needs when it comes to article access policies.

If your funder or institute mandate any aspect of Open Access, we recommend that you select the journal's Gold Open Access option during submission. Your article will be published under a CC-BY licence and research papers will be deposited into PMC for immediate release. JEB charges an article processing fee of £2,500 (plus VAT if applicable) for this Gold Open Access option, increasing to £2,750 for new submissions from November 1st 2019. This includes costs relating to quality peer review; support for academic editors; plagiarism and image manipulation checks; text and figure editing; layout; and online hosting, dissemination and archiving. If you pay for Open Access publication and we fail to fulfil these Open Access commitments, an APC rebate is available – please contact the editorial office.

If you do not have any specific Open Access needs, your article will be published automatically under the Green Open Access model. For the first six months your article will only be accessible by subscribers of the journal. After six months, the article will be made freely available for everyone. Publishing under the Green Open Access model in JEB is completely free.

If you do not want your article to be Gold Open Access, but must comply with PMC deposition mandates, it is essential that you fully and correctly indicate all funder/institute PMC mandates for all authors as part of the submission process. Your research paper will then be deposited in PMC for release after 6 or 12 months as mandated. This is a free service offered to authors of research papers who require deposition. If you fail to select the correct options during submission and PMC deposition is requested at a later stage, we reserve the right to charge \$50 for the PMC deposition service.

We are also a member of CHORUS and will ensure that your article complies with US public access mandates.

These options should allow you to comply with any funder / institute mandates.

Authors should be aware that some article types are already free to read on our site: Editorial, Publisher's Note, Correction, Retraction, Obituary, Inside JEB, Outside JEB, Special Issues and occasional other selected articles.

Data mining

Article full text, metadata and citations may be crawled without special permission or registration, on the condition that it is non-commercial. We are happy to consider commercial TDM requests – please email requests to tdm@biologists.com. We ask that where you reuse content you attribute the original source e.g. by citing doi and linking to the published article on the journal website, and that you respect the copyright of the original articles.

Please bear in mind that our technology provider sets a limit on downloads from our sites (TDM requests no more than 10 pages per minute), beyond which an automatic lock-out is triggered. If you have any other technical queries, please email tdm@biologists.com.

In addition, The Company of Biologists participates in HighWire Current, which is a secure FTP site containing metadata (citations, headers, DOIs and abstracts) for all new journal content. There is no charge to retrieve content from this repository; to apply for a username and password, email highwirecurrent@highwire.org.
