Changes to be made by the Author(s) regarding the video:

1. Video & Audio Editing:

- The audio volume levels of the introduction and conclusion segments with Kirsch and Kong should be reduced by 25%. The narration volume is ideal.

- 01:35 This close up photo of the Diethyl pyrocarbonate would benefit from a smooth fade on screen as opposed to the hard cut-in. It really pops on quickly and the audience won't be expecting it. Try a fade-on and fade-off. Do this for all freeze frame closeups (like the imidazol at 01:46)

This has been changed as suggested.

- 02:26 There is a pop here after the word "minute." Do a quick audio fade out here to smooth out the hum and eliminate the pop.

- 03:21 There is a pop here after the word "concentration." Do a quick audio fade out here to smooth out the hum and eliminate the pop.
